1. Internal Data Governance

- **Focus:** Structuring data to support operations and decision-making.
 - Key data points include occupancy rates for men's and women's dorms and other metrics for the CEO dashboard.
 - Data will provide a monthly view, trend analysis for multi-month and annual perspectives, and help in identifying areas for operational improvement.

Action Item:

 Jerry is developing a dashboard template to be showcased at the next board meeting.

2. Policies, Procedures, and Bylaws

Updates:

o Current policies and procedures have been updated.

Van Policy:

 Additions for the van will be excluded from the current updates and added later as an addendum.

Action Items:

- o Board to review and vote on updated policies and procedures.
- Review van usage policy and consider drafting a Memo of Understanding (MOU) or liability release form for outside agency use (e.g., Street2Feet).
- Ben will reach out to other organizations to gather example policies for van usage.
- o Target date for van policy approval: February 2025 board meeting.

3. External Governance, Policy Awareness, and Advocacy

Focus Areas:

- Stay informed on city, state, and federal policy, law, and regulation changes or proposals.
- o Actively engage in discussions and advocate for the organization's interests.
- o Identify opportunities to represent the community's interests in relevant forums.

4. Advisory Committee Establishment

- **Goal:** Form an advisory committee to strengthen governance and community representation.
 - Review and make necessary updates to bylaws, policies, and procedures to support the advisory committee's role.
 - Target February 2025 for completion of governance updates, followed by a March recruiting campaign.

5. Medicaid Funding for Counseling Services

• Investigation Areas:

- Assess Medicaid funding opportunities for counseling services.
- Determine credentialing requirements to qualify for Medicaid funds.
- Explore service delivery options, including hiring or training staff.

 Model different scenarios to evaluate feasibility and impact of offering Medicaidfunded services.
